# SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA FOR MALE GRADUATING SENIORS FROM HAMPTON PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS

The Virginia Peninsula Education Foundation, affiliated with the Delta Beta Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., is pleased to announce its Scholarship Competition for male high school seniors, Class of 2018, who plan to attend college or pursue technical education immediately. The Foundation seeks students who have demonstrated sustained academic achievement, leadership, community involvement and good citizenship.

### **PURPOSE:**

These scholarships are awarded to encourage and assist male high school graduates of Hampton Public Schools in the continuation of their educational pursuits.

### THE SCHOLARSHIPS:

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

The applicant must be a graduating high school senior and a resident of Hampton, Virginia, who has applied for admission and been accepted to a post-secondary education program.
